THE GAMBLING CONTROL ACT

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 119(2)(b) of the Gambling Control Act, the Cabinet Secretary for Public Service, Human Capital Development and Special Programmes, in consultation with the Board, makes the following Regulations—

THE GAMBLING CONTROL (LICENSING) REGULATIONS, 2026

PART 1— PRELIMINARY PROVISIONS

Citation.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Gambling Control (Licensing) Regulations, 2026.

Interpretation.

2. In these Regulations, unless the context otherwise requires—

No. 14 of 2025.

“Act” means the Gambling Control Act, 2025;

“Authority” means the Gambling Regulatory Authority of Kenya established by section 6 of the Act;

“applicant” means a person who applies for a licence under these Regulations;

“hybrid licence” means a licence issued to an operator carrying out gambling activities including casino, bookmaker, Public lottery and Bingo;

“licence” has the meaning assigned to it under section 2 of the Act;

“licensee” has the meaning assigned to it under section 2 of the Act;

“non - online gambling” means gambling operations operated in a licensed premise or part of a premise or site to offer gambling activity including gambling machines but excludes physical gambling tables;

“prize competition” means a free entry competition to promote a product, good or service and it may include any contest, giveaway, game of chance or skill or similar activity offering prizes in connection with a trade or media content conducted by a registered business in which a participant has an

opportunity to win a prize through a process that may rely on chance, skill or a combination of both;

“random number generator” means a certified physical or electronic mechanism that generates random outcomes for National Lottery games, tested by an accredited lottery testing laboratory approved by the Authority

Application.

3. These Regulations shall apply to the licensing of gambling activities.

PART II—LICENSING

Public gambling or conducting a table game and operating a slot machine licence.

4. (1) A person who intends to offer public gambling for conducting a table game and operating a slot machine shall apply for a licence to the Authority in Form 1 set out in the First Schedule.

(2) An application under subregulation (1) shall be accompanied by—

- (a) the application fee set out in the Second Schedule of these Regulations;
- (b) a valid Tax Compliance Certificate and Personal Identification Number certificate issued by the Kenya Revenue Authority to the applicant;
- (c) a brief description of the applicant games and internal rules;
- (d) proposed floor plan of the premises;
- (e) proposed staffing plan and organizational chart of the applicant;
- (f) proposed list of machines and tables;
- (g) certification of slot machines, manufacturer details and serial numbers;
- (h) certification for the applicant equipment and devices;
- (i) demonstrate real time monitoring access and server information;
- (j) declarations under the Second Schedule of the Act;

- (k) evidence of compliance with anti-money laundering and counter-terrorism financing obligations, including internal policies, procedures, and staff training records;
- (l) proof of gambling capital set out in the Third schedule of these Regulations; and
- (m) a certificate of incorporation of the applicant if the applicant is a company incorporated under the Companies Act.

Cap. 486.

Bookmaking.

5. (1) Pursuant to section 58 of the Act, a person who intends to offer any activity related to bookmaking shall apply for a licence to the Authority in Form 2 set out in the First Schedule.

(2) The Authority may, in respect of bookmaking, issue—

- (a) an on-the-course licence authorizing a person to carry out the business of a bookmaker at any authorized race meeting;
- (b) an off-the-course licence authorizing a person to carry on the business of a bookmaker at any authorized betting premises; or
- (c) a licence authorizing a person to carry on the business as a bookmaker of both on and off the course race.

(3) An application under subregulation (1) shall be accompanied by—

- (a) the application fee set out in the Second Schedule of these Regulations;
- (b) a valid Tax Compliance Certificate and Personal Identification Number certificate issued by the Kenya Revenue Authority;
- (c) information on proposed sport events and types of bets to be offered;

- (d) information on the proposed mode of operation demonstrating capacity to operate betting service effectively;
- (e) name and address of odds and platform providers and copy of agreement with the providers;
- (f) declarations under the Second Schedule of the Act;
- (g) proposed terms and conditions and bookmaking architecture;
- (h) internal dispute resolution mechanisms;
- (i) geolocation of the applicant premises; and
- (j) proof of gambling capital set out in the Third schedule of these Regulations.

(4) A licensee under this regulation shall, upon demonstrating compliance with the conditions of the license, pay the annual operating fee prescribed in the Second Schedule

Totalisators.

6. (1) The Authority may issue any of the following licences for each totalisator—

- (a) an on-the-course licence authorizing a person to operate a totalisator on a specified course;
- (b) an off-the-course licence authorizing a person to operate a totalisator at a specified betting premise; or
- (c) a licence authorizing a person to operate a totalisator both on and off the course.

(2) A person who intends to offer on-the course and off-the course totalisators shall apply for a licence to the Authority in Form 3 set out in the First Schedule.

(3) An application under subregulation (1) shall be accompanied by—

- (a) the application fee set out in the Second Schedule of these Regulations;

- (b) a valid Tax Compliance Certificate and Personal Identification Number certificate issued by the Kenya Revenue Authority;
 - (c) security as prescribed under the Third Schedule of the Act;
 - (d) evidence of compliance with anti-money laundering and counter-terrorism financing obligations, including internal policies, procedures, and staff training records;
 - (e) proof of gambling capital set out in the Third schedule of these Regulations;
 - (f) declarations under the Second Schedule of the Act;
 - (g) audited financial statements for the preceding two financial years, prepared in accordance with International Financial Reporting Standards and audited by an auditor approved by the Authority (43(2)); and
 - (h) a certificate of incorporation of the applicant if the applicant is a company incorporated under the Companies Act.
- (4) A licensee under this regulation shall, upon demonstrating compliance with the conditions of the license, pay the annual operating fee prescribed in the Second Schedule

Prize competition.

7. (1) A person who intends to offer a prize competition shall apply for a licence to the Authority in Form 4 set out in the First Schedule.

(2) The Authority may issue the following types of licences for conduct of prize competition—

- (a) a license authorizing promotion of prize competition for commercial purposes; and

- (b) a license authorizing promotion of prize competition for non-commercial purposes.
- (3) An application under subregulation (1) shall be accompanied by—
- (a) the application fee prescribed in the Second Schedule of these Regulations;
 - (b) a valid Tax Compliance Certificate and Personal Identification Number certificate issued by the Kenya Revenue Authority;
 - (c) brief description of the product being promoted and the reason for conducting the competition;
 - (d) detailed proposal on how members of the public will participate in the competition;
 - (e) duration of the competition;
 - (f) detailed terms and conditions for the promotion;
 - (g) declarations under the Second Schedule of the Act;
 - (h) method to be used to determine the winners;
 - (i) where the method used is software detailed, evidence on its capability of determining winners and certification;
 - (j) proposed promotional material artwork indicating the prizes, mode of entry and promotion period;
 - (k) detailed media advertisement schedule specifying the media to be used, design, content and number of promotional material and all the related cost for each;
 - (l) letter of commitment confirming stock availability where the promoter is providing a prize or any other product it produces or markets;

- (m) certified copy of a delivery note or purchase receipts where the prize is a product not ordinarily stocked by the promoter;
- (n) proof of gambling capital set out in the Third schedule of these Regulations;
- (o) evidence of compliance with anti-money laundering and counter-terrorism financing obligations, including internal policies, procedures, and staff training records;
- (p) audited financial statements for the preceding two financial years, prepared in accordance with International Financial Reporting Standards and audited by an auditor approved by the Authority;
- (q) a certificate of incorporation of the applicant if the applicant is a company incorporated under the Companies Act; and
- (r) the concept or the proposed promotion reasonably prevents or discriminates a significant proportion of persons who wish to participate in the prize competition.

Bingo.

8. (1) A person who intends to play bingo shall apply for a licence in Form 5 set out in the First Schedule.

(2) An application under subregulation (1) shall be accompanied by—

- (a) the application fee set out in the Second Schedule of these Regulations;
- (b) a valid Tax Compliance Certificate and Personal Identification Number certificate issued by the Kenya Revenue Authority;
- (c) proof of gambling capital set out in the Third schedule of these Regulations;

- (d) a certified random number generator system to draw numbers;
- (e) a brief details of proposed bingo games and rules;
- (f) detailed format of prize allocation;
- (g) a specimen of a bingo ticket;
- (h) proposed mode of operation;
- (i) declarations under the Second Schedule of the Act;
- (j) name, address and certification of the provider of bingo equipment and devices;
- (k) evidence of compliance with anti-money laundering and counter-terrorism financing obligations, including internal policies, procedures, and staff training records; and
- (l) the proposed physical premise and floor layout.

Pool betting scheme.

9. (1) A person who intends to offer a pool betting scheme shall apply for a licence in Form 6 set out in the First Schedule.

(2) An application under subregulation (1) shall be accompanied by—

- (a) the application fee prescribed in the Second Schedule of these Regulations;
- (b) a valid Tax Compliance Certificate and Personal Identification Number certificate issued by the Kenya Revenue Authority for the applicant;
- (c) proof of gambling capital set out in the Third schedule of these Regulations;
- (d) declarations under the Second Schedule of the Act; and
- (e) evidence of compliance with anti-money laundering and counter-terrorism financing obligations, including internal

policies, procedures, and staff training records.

(3) A licensee under this regulation shall, upon demonstrating compliance with the conditions of the license, pay the annual operating fee prescribed in the Second Schedule

Public lotteries.

10.(1) A person who intends to offer a public lottery shall apply for a licence by submitting an application to the Authority in Form 7 set out in the First Schedule.

(2) An application under subregulation (1) shall be accompanied by—

- (a) the application fee set out in the Second Schedule of these Regulations;
- (b) a valid Tax Compliance Certificate and Personal Identification Number certificate issued by the Kenya Revenue Authority;
- (c) proposed lottery format including draw-based, instant, promotional, electronic or hybrid;
- (d) proposed ticketing and sales system whether physical or electronic;
- (e) proposed lottery infrastructure and the lottery management system which is compatible with the Authority central management system;
- (f) a specimen of each type of ticket or chance to be sold;
- (g) declarations under the Second Schedule of the Act;
- (h) detailed set of rules under which ticket must be sold;
- (i) proposed lottery games and rules;
- (j) clear terms and conditions for Lottery operation;

- (k) proposed lottery terminals;
- (l) detailed prize pay-outs rules, verification and claim timelines;
- (m) name and address of certified draw equipment and devices provider detailing prize management, draw protocols and records;
- (n) proof of gambling capital set out in the Third schedule of these Regulations; and
- (o) evidence of compliance with anti-money laundering and counter-terrorism financing obligations, including internal policies, procedures, and staff training records.

(3) A licensee under this regulation shall, upon demonstrating compliance with the conditions of the license, pay the annual operating fee prescribed in the Second Schedule

Online gambling.

11.(1) Pursuant to section 67 of the Act, a person who intends to operate, sell or promote online gambling shall apply for a licence in Form 8 set out in the First Schedule from the Authority for the following—

- (a) an online bookmakers' licence;
- (b) an online lottery licence; or
- (c) an online casino licence.

(2) An application under subregulation (1) shall be accompanied by—

- (a) the application fee prescribed in the Second Schedule of these Regulations;
- (b) a valid Tax Compliance Certificate and Personal Identification Number certificate issued by the Kenya Revenue Authority of the applicant;

- (c) a proposed gambling control system compatible with the Authority central management system;
- (d) declarations under the Second Schedule of the Act;
- (e) proof of gambling capital set out in the Third schedule of these Regulations; and
- (f) evidence of compliance with anti-money laundering and counter-terrorism financing obligations, including internal policies, procedures, and staff training records; and
- (g) proposed platform, domain name and games provider from a licensed gambling supplier by the Authority and copy of agreement.

(3) A licensee under this regulation shall, upon demonstrating compliance with the conditions of the license, pay the annual operating fee prescribed in the Second Schedule

Gambling equipment and device manufacture or assembling.

12.(1) A person who intends to manufacture, assemble gambling equipment and devices shall apply for a licence in Form 9 set out in the First Schedule.

(2) An application under subregulation (1) shall be accompanied by—

- (a) the application fee prescribed in the Second Schedule of these Regulations;
- (b) a valid Tax Compliance Certificate and Personal Identification Number certificate issued by the Kenya Revenue Authority for the applicant;
- (c) details of the entity’s corporate structure and business plan;
- (d) proof of gambling capital set out in the Third schedule of these Regulations;

- (e) name, address and certification of the provider of bingo equipment and devices;
- (f) evidence of compliance with anti-money laundering and counter-terrorism financing obligations, including internal policies, procedures, and staff training records; and
- (g) declarations under the Second Schedule of the Act.

Gambling equipment and device sale or distribution.

13.(1) A person who intends to sell or distribute gambling equipment and device shall apply for a licence in Form 10 set out in the First Schedule.

(2) An application under subregulation (1) shall be accompanied by—

- (a) the application fee prescribed in the Second Schedule of these Regulations;
- (b) a valid Tax Compliance Certificate and Personal Identification Number certificate issued by the Kenya Revenue Authority;
- (c) proof of gambling capital set out in the Third schedule of these Regulations;
- (d) declarations under the Second Schedule of the Act; and
- (e) evidence of compliance with anti-money laundering and counter-terrorism financing obligations, including internal policies, procedures, and staff training records.

Gambling equipment testing.

14.(1) A person who intends to offer gambling equipment testing service shall apply for a licence to the Authority in Form 11 set out in the First Schedule.

(2) An application under subregulation (1) shall be accompanied by—

- (a) the application fee prescribed in the Second Schedule of these Regulations;

- (b) a valid Tax Compliance Certificate and Personal Identification Number certificate issued by the Kenya Revenue Authority;
- (c) proof of gambling capital set out in the Third schedule of these Regulations;
- (d) declarations under the Second Schedule of the Act; and
- (e) evidence of compliance with anti-money laundering and counter-terrorism financing obligations, including internal policies, procedures, and staff training records.

Gambling software or platform.

15.(1) A person who intends to provide any gambling software or platform shall apply for a licence in Form 12 set out in the First Schedule.

(2) An application under subregulation (1) shall be accompanied by—

- (a) the application fee prescribed in the Second Schedule of these Regulations;
- (b) a valid Tax Compliance Certificate and Personal Identification Number certificate issued by the Kenya Revenue Authority;
- (c) proof of gambling capital set out in the Third schedule of these Regulations;
- (d) declarations under the Second Schedule of the Act; and
- (e) evidence of compliance with anti-money laundering and counter-terrorism financing obligations, including internal policies, procedures, and staff training records.

Gambling equipment repair and servicing.

16.(1) A person who intends to offer gambling equipment repair and servicing services shall apply for a licence in Form 13 set out in the Schedule.

(2) An application under subregulation (1) shall be accompanied by—

- (a) the application fee prescribed in the Second Schedule of these Regulations;
- (b) a valid Tax Compliance Certificate and Personal Identification Number certificate issued by the Kenya Revenue Authority;
- (c) security as prescribed under the Third Schedule of the Act;
- (d) proof of gambling capital set out in the Third schedule of these Regulations;
- (e) declarations under the Second Schedule of the Act; and
- (f) evidence of compliance with anti-money laundering and counter-terrorism financing obligations, including internal policies, procedures, and staff training records.

Gambling employees.

17.(1) Key gambling employees shall apply for a licence by submitting an application to the Authority in Form 14 set out in the First Schedule.

(2) An application under subregulation (1) shall be accompanied by—

- (a) the application fee prescribed in the Second Schedule of these Regulations;
- (b) a valid Tax Compliance Certificate and Personal Identification Number certificate issued by the Kenya Revenue Authority;
- (c) a valid Certificate of Good Conduct issued by the Directorate of Criminal Investigations in respect of every key employee of the applicant;
- (d) copies of identity cards or passports of the key employees of the applicant;
- (e) where a key employee is a foreign national, a work permit issued under the Kenya Citizenship and Immigration Act;

- (f) the particulars of the shareholders and directors of the applicant issued by the Registrar of Companies in accordance with section 854 of the Companies Act within the preceding twelve months prior to making the application; and
- (g) academic and professional qualifications.

Media promotions with prizes and prize competitions cutting across several counties.

18.(1) A person who intends to conduct a media promotion with prizes or prize competitions cutting across more than one county shall apply for a licence in Form 15 set out in the First Schedule.

(2) An application under subregulation (1) shall be accompanied by—

- (a) the application fee prescribed in the Second Schedule of these Regulations;
- (b) a valid Tax Compliance Certificate and Personal Identification Number certificate issued by the Kenya Revenue Authority;
- (c) a valid Certificate of Good Conduct issued by the Directorate of Criminal Investigations in respect of every director, shareholder and key employee of the applicant;
- (d) declarations under the Second Schedule of the Act;
- (e) whether the intention for the promotion shall be to increase audience engagement, including viewership, listenership and overall loyalty to a station or program;
- (f) the mode of participation or entry into the promotion;
- (g) confirmation of the entry into the promotion is free;
- (h) the proposed process to determine or select winners;
- (i) whether participants are required to exercise any skill, judgment or display of

knowledge on the product being promoted; and

- (j) the concept or the proposed promotion;
- (k) evidence of compliance with anti-money laundering and counter-terrorism financing obligations, including internal policies, procedures, and staff training records.

Requirements for licensing. **19.**A person shall be eligible to apply for a licence, if the person meets the requirements provided under section 29 of the Act.

Processing of applications. **20.**(1) On receipt of an application for a licence under these Regulations, the Authority shall, within fourteen days from the date of receipt of the application, review the application and notify the applicant, request the applicant for additional information, where necessary.

(2) Before granting or refusing to grant a license under these Regulations, the Authority shall in addition to the requirements under section 30 of the Act, consider—

- (a) the background, reputation, integrity, experience and capacity of the proposed significant shareholders, directors and senior officers of the applicant;
- (b) the design of data collection for customer information and flexibility in structuring the information;
- (c) the adequacy of the applicant's capital structure;
- (d) the availability of human, financial and operational resources necessary for the effective and efficient conduct of the applicant business;
- (e) the ability of the applicant to maintain the confidentiality of customer information;
- (f) the applicant's ability to conduct effective due diligence and identity verification on the legal capacity of the customers; and

(g) whether the applicant has complied with the requirements of the Act and these Regulations.

(2) All applications shall be considered within thirty days after the submission of the application.

Licence.

21.(1) Upon approval of an application for a licence under this Regulations, the Authority shall require an applicant to deposit with the Authority to—

(a) pay the licence fee set out the Second Schedule; and

(b) deposit the applicable security prescribed set out in the Third Schedule of the Act or the Third Schedule of these Regulations.

(2) Where the Authority is satisfied that the Applicant has complied with the requirements of the Act and these Regulations, the Authority shall grant the applicant the license in Form 16 set out in the Schedule.

(3) Where the Authority refuses to grant a licence to an applicant, the Authority shall notify the applicant in writing of the refusal and specify the grounds for the refusal in the notification within fourteen days of the decision.

Duration of a licence.

22. (1) The duration of every licence issued under these Regulations shall be as prescribed in the Fourth Schedule.

Inspection of systems and premises.

23. The Authority shall carry out an on-site inspection of the applicant's premises to determine the adequacy of the applicant's safety and security systems and to confirm—

(a) the suitability of the premises for the applicant's operations;

(b) the adequacy of the applicant's management information system, administrative and operational processes and internal control systems;

- (c) the security of information held by the applicant; and
- (d) the separation of the proposed applicant business from any other business carried out by the applicant or the applicant's associates.

Renewal of a licence.

22 (1) A person who intends to renew a licence shall—

- (a) comply with the specific requirements for each licence under these Regulations;
- (b) apply to the Authority in the respective Form set out in the First Schedule; and
- (c) remit to the Authority the fees in the Second Schedule of these Regulations.

(2) An application under subregulation (1) shall be made a least ninety days before the expiry of the licence.

(3) Within thirty days after an application being made under subregulation (1), the Authority shall issue a successful applicant with a licence.

(4) Where an application being made under subregulation (1) is rejected, the Authority shall notify the applicant of the reasons for the rejection in writing within seven days of the rejection.

(5) The duration of every renewed licence issued under these Regulations shall be as prescribed in the Fourth Schedule.

Rejection of application.

23 The Authority may refuse to issue a licence to an applicant if the applicant fails to comply with any of the requirements set out in the Act or under these Regulations.

Suspension or revocation of a licence.

24 (1) The Authority may suspend or revoke a licence where the licensee—

- (a) does not commence business within six months from the date it was issued with a license;

- (b) has ceased or suspended operations for a period exceeding three months without approval from the Authority;
- (c) fails to keep any of the records required to be kept in accordance with the provisions of the Act and these Regulations;
- (d) obtained the licence by providing wrong, false or misleading information or the concealment of material information which, if known at the time of evaluating the application for a licence, the applicant would not have been granted a licence;
- (e) has failed to comply with any conditions imposed on the licence;
- (f) is insolvent or unable to effectively conduct its operations;
- (g) is unable or has consistently failed to protect the confidentiality of data or information in its possession or control;
- (h) fails to submit the records required to be submitted under the Act and these regulations to the Authority;
- (i) has, without the consent of the Authority and other relevant government agencies, amalgamated with another entity or sold or otherwise transferred its business, assets or liabilities to another entity;
- (j) has had a winding-up order made against it or a resolution for the voluntary winding up of the licensee has been passed by its shareholders;
- (k) fails to pay the annual licence fee in accordance with these Regulation; or
- (l) fails the audit requirements under the Act and these Regulations.

(2) The Authority shall, before revoking or suspending a licence issued under these Regulations, give a licensee an opportunity to make representations as to why the licence should not be

revoked or suspended and the Authority shall take into consideration the representations made by the licensee in its decision on the matter.

(3) The Authority may, in lieu of revoking or suspending the licence, require the licensee to take such measures as may be necessary to regularise the breach or violation within such period as the Authority may specify and impose such monetary or other sanctions as it may consider necessary in the circumstances.

(4) The Authority shall, within seven days of suspending or revoking a license, inform the affected licensee of the suspension or revocation in writing and the reasons for suspension or revocation.

(5) The Authority shall, upon revocation of the licence, take over control of the business of the licensee to safeguard the information in the licensee's possession or control and facilitate the winding up of the licensee business

(6) Where the Authority takes over the licensee business under subregulation (5), the licensee shall hand over the entire database in a format as the Authority may specify and shall thereafter erase all data in its database in the manner specified by the Authority.

(7) Where a licence is revoked by the Authority, the holder of the licence shall, within seven days from the date of being notified of the revocation, surrender the licence to Authority and shall cease to carry out business or any other activity authorized under these Regulations.

(8) A person who fails to comply with subregulation (7) commits an offence and shall, on conviction, be liable to a fine not exceeding five hundred thousand shillings or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding two years or to both.

(9) The Authority shall publish in the *Gazette* a notice of the suspension or revocation of a license issued under these Regulations and the grounds for the suspension or revocation.

PART III—GENERAL PROVISIONS

Fees not refundable or payable pro rata.

25 Any fees payable to the Authority under these Regulations shall not be—

- (a) refundable where the licence is cancelled or revoked or a Bureau ceases to carry on business;
- (b) shall not be payable on a pro rata basis if the licence fee is paid in the course of the year for the commencement of licensee business.

License transferable. non-

26 (1) A person shall not transfer a licence issued by the Authority under these Regulations to another person.

(2) A person who contravenes subregulation (1) commits an offence and shall be liable, on conviction, to a fine not exceeding one million shillings.

Trademark.

27 A licensee shall trademark the name of the licensee and submit the certificate of registration from the relevant government agency to the Authority within ninety days of being licenced by the Authority.

Offence and penalty.

28 A person who operates without a licence required under these Regulations commits an offence and shall be liable upon conviction to a fine not exceeding one million shillings or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding six months, or to both.
