**GAMBLING REGULATORY AUTHORITY  
GAMBLING CONTROL ACT  
(NO. 14 OF 2025)**

**CALL FOR PUBLIC PARTICIPATION**

---

The Gambling Control Act was assented to on 7<sup>th</sup> August 2025 and came into operation on 20<sup>th</sup> August 2025, ushering Kenya into a new era of gambling regulation through the establishment of a modern, robust, and coherent legal framework for the sector. Central to this reform was the transition of the Betting Control and Licensing Board into the Gambling Regulatory Authority, which is vested with broad powers to effectively oversee and regulate the sector.

To fully operationalize the Act, the Executive Office of the President, Office of the Chief of Staff and Head of the Public Service, through the Gambling Regulatory Authority, has developed Regulations. These Regulations are imperative as they provide the detailed operational framework necessary to ensure a transparent, accountable, and well-regulated gambling sector. Collectively, they give effect to the Act and enable the Authority to discharge its mandate effectively, while safeguarding the public interest and promoting responsible gambling practices.

The Regulations proposed for consideration are—

- 1) The Gambling Control (Licensing) Regulations, 2026**
- 2) The Gambling Control (Conduct of Gambling Operations) Regulations, 2026**

- 3) **The Gambling Control (National Lottery) Regulations, 2026**
- 4) **The Gambling Control (Advertising) Regulations, 2026**
- 5) **The Gambling Control (Gambling Appeals Tribunal) Regulations, 2026**
- 6) **The Gambling Control (Foreign-Facing Operators) Regulations, 2026**

In line with the constitutional imperative of ensuring wide consultation and public participation, the Executive Office of the President and the Gambling Regulatory Authority, invites institutions, organizations, and individuals to submit their comments on the aforementioned Regulations.
